

Halifax County 2-day Heart Racing Itinerary

Day One:

Your first stop - the Halifax County Visitor Center at 1180 Bill Tuck Highway, South Boston, VA 24592 to get your maps, directions, brochures, general information and race tickets.

Bring your appetite; Smokin' Jake's House of BBQ is "all good, over wood." They serve breakfast too. Or you could head to Spare Times Grill, a full service bar and grill in the World of Sports complex.

Thus fortified, stretch your legs with a stroll around downtown South Boston. Be sure to visit the "Crossing of the Dan" exhibit in The Prizery, which marks a major Halifax County contribution to America's race for independence. You can track the course of our downtown fire hydrant walking tour; local artists have painted hydrants in the likenesses of local historic figures.



Browse the Main Street antiques and delightful sundries in the various shops.

Grab a pick-me-up gourmet coffee and snack at Common Grounds on your way to SoBo Speedway.

Night race qualifying begins at 5:30 pm, with green flag at 7:00pm.

Qualifying for the afternoon races begins at 12:45pm with green flag at 2:00pm, so you can switch around the order of your day if you wish.
