

Southern Virginia Wild Blueway

Imagine a paddling experience unlike any other: Over 100 miles of navigable river, leading to 1,200 miles of beautiful lake shoreline. Experience unspoiled wilderness and abundant fish and wildlife, just a short drive from major cities. Enjoy waterfront camping with no crowds, just minutes from great restaurants, hotels, and outfitters – all along one freshwater trail that is perfect for a few hours in a canoe with the kids or a few days in kayaks with your friends. This is the promise of the Southern Virginia Wild Blueway – amazing scenery, world-class fishing, and miles upon miles of pure paddling adventure.

Dan River

The Dan River is the major tributary of the Staunton River and has two public boat landings and access at one bridge crossing in Halifax County.

Banister River

The Banister enters Halifax County from Pittsylvania County near Hermosa, and has one public boat landing and four bridge crossings in Halifax County.



Staunton River

Known as a popular destination for paddlers, the Staunton River forms the northern and eastern border of Halifax County for more than 50 miles before it merges with the Dan to form Buggs Island Lake (Kerr Lake). Its famed whitewater is found in the stretch between Long Island and Brookneal. There are two public boat landings on the Halifax County side of the river and two on the opposite shores in Campbell County.

Kerr Lake

Kerr Lake, officially known as John H. Kerr Reservoir, or locally known as Buggs Island Lake, is Virginia's largest with 50,000 acres of water and over 800 miles of shoreline that extends into North Carolina. It is one of the most beautiful, serene, and uncrowded lakes you're going to experience. Visitors will find outstanding fishing and camping. Kerr Lake holds the world record with a 143-pound blue catfish caught in its waters in 2011.

<u>Lakes</u>

Banister Lake

Banister Lake is a 400-acre impoundment in the Town of Halifax. Anglers fishing Banister Lake are likely to catch Largemouth Bass, Channel Catfish, Bluegill, Redear Sunfish (AKA shellcracker), Chain Pickerel, and Crappie.

Lake Conner

Lake Conner is a 100-acre impoundment in the northern part of Halifax County. Lake Conner offers anglers great fishing opportunities in a picturesque, wooded setting. Lake Conner is best known for holding the state record largemouth bass (16 pounds, 4 ounces) since 1985. Anglers fishing Lake Conner are likely to catch largemouth bass, channel catfish, black crappie, bluegill, redear sunfish, chain pickerel, yellow perch, and bullhead catfish.

Lake Gaston

Lake Gaston, makes up the other flatwater portion of the Southern Virginia Wild Blueway. Smaller than Kerr Lake, but no less impressive at 20,000 acres, Lake Gaston is a wellknown recreation and resort-style lake.

<u>Parks</u>

Edmunds Park

Edmunds Park overlooks a pond in the rolling countryside of what was once a dairy farm. The park offers many activities including volleyball, basketball, children's playground, Serenity Garden, fishing, and several pavilions with grills. It is also home to the Southern Virginia Botanical Garden which features flora native to the region. The botanical gardens consist of an arboretum, therapeutic garden, nature trail, and a children's garden. The park also features one of the best disc golf facilities in the state.








Walking Tours

Forget generic cityscapes and neon-lit avenues. In our quaint downtowns, history whispers from every brick and covered porch. Join us on an unforgettable walking tour through Downtown South Boston and the Town of Halifax, where architecture isn't just mortar and stone, but a captivating tapestry woven with tales of the past.

The self-guided tours take you through the South Boston Historic District, one of the largest and most architecturally interesting historic districts in Southern Virginia. It is representative of the community's industrial, commercial, and residential development from the 19th century to the 1930s. Travel north to the Town of Halifax to the Mountain Road Historic District to what has been highly regarded for its distinguished architecture and beautiful landscape since the early 20th century. Its unique qualities have now been recognized by the Virginia Historic Landmarks Commission, which designated it a state historic district and the National Register of Historic Places.

Crossing of the Dan

On February 14, 1781, American General Nathaniel Greene achieved one of the greatest victories of the American Revolution, not in battle but by succeeding in a maneuver remembered today as "The Crossing of the Dan." The Crossing of the Dan became a turning point in the American Revolution, precipitating events that led to the British surrender at Yorktown.






<u>Halifax County</u> <u>Historical Society</u>

Unveilied in 2024, this statue pays tribute to former resident Henrietta Lacks, known as The Mother of Modern Medicine.

Her immortal cells, called HELA, have been used in various medical breakthroughs since being discovered in 1951.

Rosenwald Schools

Created by Booker T. Washington and the Tuskegee Institute and funded in part by businessman and philanthropist Julius Rosenwald, the Rosenwald rural school building program was an initiative intended to narrow racial schooling gaps in the South by constructing better, more-accessible schools for African Americans. Between 1912 and 1932, the program helped produce 5,357 new educational facilities for African Americans across 15 southern states, providing almost 700,000 African American children in rural, isolated communities with state-of-the-art facilities at a time when little to no public money was put toward black education. In Halifax County, 14 schools were constructed and today, only two remain standing.


Constructed in 1921, this building contained four classrooms and a large hall.

From sleek Formula cars screaming around VIR to world-class driving and training schools, Halifax is a buffet for any speed demon.

It's an experience. It's a family tradition passed down through generations, a community united by the roar of the engines, and a place where adrenaline is as precious as gold. So come on down, buckle up, and let Halifax County show you what real racing is all about.

<u>Virginia International</u> <u>Raceway</u>

VIR's a motorsport oasis! Virginia International Raceway was born in 1957, saw legends like Richard Petty and Wendell Scott tear up the asphalt. It closed for a pit stop in '74, but roared back in 2000, bigger and better than ever. No cookiecutter oval here. VIR's 3.27-mile masterpiece twists and turns with six exhilarating configurations. Need more? Two can run at once! Car and Driver loves it, calling it one of the country's top-six road courses; racers adore it, and you will

VIR isn't just about speed. It's a full-blown resort with lodging, go-karts, a restaurant and bar, a pool, and even an F1 simulator. Whether you're a gearhead fanatic or just want a heart-pumping weekend escape, VIR has your number. It's more than a race, it's an experience.

South Boston Speedway


South Boston Speedway has been making hearts pound since 1957! Back then, it was a dirt track where legends like Richard Petty and Rex White kicked up dust storms. Soon, it joined the NASCAR family, hosting epic battles between Joe Weatherly and Wendell Scott. Even after the top series left in 1971, the roar of engines never faded. Dale Earnhardt Sr., Dale Jr., Terry Labonte, and Tony Stewart all tore up the asphalt, keeping the legacy alive. Today it is a state-of-the-art short track at 4/10 miles with 12 degrees of banking in the turns and 10 degrees on its 360-yard straightaways. The 45-foot width helps passing and keeps the racing close. South Boston Speedway continues keeping the spirit of racing alive, one lap at a time.



A LOT TO LOVE HALIFAX COUNTY

South Boston -Halifax County Visitor Center

1180 Bill Tuck Highway, South Boston

This **LOVEworks** displays the heritage fo Halifax County. The "L" features a Revolutionary War Soldier, paying homage to the Crossing of the Dan. The "O" is a tractor tire, a reminder of our agrarian roots. Celebrating the Blueway, the "V" is crafted from two canoes. Latly, the checkered "E" represents the county's tracks and racing history.



Viriginia International Raceway

1245 Pine Tree Road, Alton

This **LOVEworks** sign features a "V" inspired by the shape of the track found at the Virginia International Raceway. The sign was designed by the staff at VIR and the Southern Virginia Higher Education Center's CAD and Welding programs. The trailer that the sign is mounted on was donated by Virginia-based business. Pro-Line Trailers, A VIR sponsor and supporter of tourism.



Springfield Distillery

9040 River Road, Halifax

This **LOVEworks** represents Springfield's past and future. The "L" pays tribute to the owners' love of craftsmanship. Springfield's logo appears in the "O" atop an anvil. The "V" is made from two tobacco leaves, signifying the farm's past. Lastly, the "E" sits within a barrel, representing Springfield's current use as a distillery, over 1842, the year the historic house was built.





STAUNTON RIVER

Tucked neatly into the heart of Virginia, about 25 miles from the North Carolina border, Staunton River offers much to families and outdoor enthusiasts. The 2,400-acre park boasts woodlands, meadows, and shoreline along the Dan and Staunton Rivers.





One of the original six state parks of Virginia, the park first opened in June 1936. The historic cabins, shelters, and visitor center were built by the Civilian Conservation Corps. The campground opened in the 1940's, and a new equestrian campground opened in the last decade. The cabins remain in high demand and are often booked yearround, with the campgrounds open seasonally from March to November.


STATE PARK

Access to Virginia's largest lake, Buggs Island Lake, offers freshwater fishing, boating, along with water skiing and many aquatic activities. The park also has picnic shelters, three playgrounds, tennis and volleyball courts, several boat launches, and more than 17 miles of muti-use trails.





This park is the first state park in Virginia to be designated an International Dark Sky Park and the 25th in the world. The dark skies here are ideal for stargazing. Park staff conducts associated interpretive programs and loan telescopes to campers.
